Emblem



The emblem of the GUJARAT VIDYAPITH is an open lotus flower. In it, in Devanagari script, is written “Sa Vidya Ya Vimuktaye” i.e. knowledge is that which liberates (us). In Arabic is written “al hikamatozallatulmonimi nefahaisouajedahaahakkoleha.”

In this emblem there is a Banyan tree i.e. Ficus benghalensis, which signifies growth. There is also the moon that symbolizes beauty, calmness and development. Lotus shows non-attachment, holy spirit. Lamps on either side in a circle symbolize knowledge.

The Gujarat Vidyapith was established for attachment of independence. The object of political independence was temporary but devotion for self-liberation and knowledge are our permanent ideals. This devotion should continue to grow like a banyan tree and moon with a spirit of non-attachment of a lotus.

GUJARAT VIDYAPITH
(Deemed to be University)
(founded by Mahatma Gandhiji in 1920)



Gandhiji started a nationwide non-cooperation movement in 1920. As a part of this movement, he launched a nationwide movement of boycotting of English schools and colleges. However, he was not satisfied with a mere program of boycott. He also wanted to reform the country along with non-violent struggle. Gandhiji wanted to awaken new consciousness and prepare the people for complete swaraj. Hence, he introduced Constructive programs along with the inculcation of the Ekadash Vrats (The Eleven Vows). National education became important in these programs. Along with the call for boycott of English education, Gandhi created a positive atmosphere for the establishment of National Universities. As a result, Gujarat Vidyapith was founded by Gandhi in 1920 AD. Gandhiji dreamed public awareness and regeneration through education. He said in the inaugural speech of Gujarat Mahavidyalaya affiliated to Gujarat Vidyapith, 'I have only given a mantra. I have done the work of a Rishi (Sage), if a son of Baniya can do it.' With a glorious history of a century, Gujarat Vidyapith continues to permeate education based on Gandhian principles. The three H's theory- Head, Hand, and Heart – aims at educating students holistically through the development of head, hand, and heart. Gujarat Vidyapith, dedicated to Gandhian values, stands unique in the academic world and social life.

Gujarat Vidyapith has been granted Deemed to be University status by the UGC (University Grants Commission) since 1963. Gujarat Vidyapith was started as a national educational institution. Mahatma Gandhi served as the Chancellor of Gujarat Vidyapith till 1948. The main objective of the institute is to prepare full of integrity, energetic and dedicated workers for the nation for initiatives related to the regeneration of the country in accordance with the ideals given by Mahatma Gandhi.

Accordingly, the education system of Gujarat Vidyapith includes community work, hostel life, social service, community life, prayer, simple and self-sufficient life, practical work experience and field work, labor and cleaning, spinning and participation in industrial work. The education program has been aligned with the national needs of rural upliftment, so that education is promoted at the grass root levels of society. The mission of Gujarat Vidyapith is to conduct experiments in various fields of education to develop Gandhian thought and values in all aspects of education.

Gujarat Vidyapith has been fortunate to have the luminous personalities like Mahatma Gandhi, Sardar Patel, Dr. Rajendra Prasad, Moraraji Desai, Ramlal Parikh, Dr. Sushila Naiyar, Naveenchandra Barot, Navalbhai Shah, Ravindra Varma, Narayan Desai, and Ila Bhatt as the chancellors. At present His Highness Governor of Gujarat, Acharya Devvrat ji is leading Gujarat Vidhyapith as the Chancellor.



Goals

1. The prime task of Gujarat Vidyapith is to prepare characterful, energetic, civilized and conscientious workers for the purpose of renovating the country according to the ideals directed by Mahatma Gandhi.
2. The faculty and administrators of Vidyapith will adopt and strive to implement the nonviolent and nonconflicting to the truth.
3. The administrators and teachers of the institutions run by Vidyapith and recognized by it shall consider untouchability as a stigma and endeavor to eradicate it and no child (Male or Female) shall be excluded on the grounds of being untouchable or subjected to unfair treatment on those grounds after admission.
4. The teaching staff, administrators and recognized institutions etc. working in connection with the Vidyapith shall be believers in Spinning Wheel (Retinya) activities and regular spinners and constant wearers of khadi except for compelling reason.
5. Mother Tongue (Swa-bhasha) will be given priority in Vidyapith, and all education will be given in Mother Tongue (Swa-bhasha). Explanation- Teaching of a second language will be done using the same language.
6. National language Hindi-Hindustani will have an essential place in Vidyapith.
Note: - Hindi-Hindustani is the language spoken by common Hindu-Muslims in the north and written in Devanagari or Persian script.
7. In Vidyapith industrial education will be given equal importance as intellectual education and industries which are the breadwinner of the nation will be given place and not others.
8. The wellbeing of Bharatvarsha depends not on the cities but on the villages, so most of the means of Vidyapith and the teachers of Vidyapith will be mainly employed in promoting national education in the villages.
9. The needs of the villagers will be given priority in formulating the Curriculum of Vidyapith.
10. Institutions run under Vidyapith will have full respect for all the prevailing religions, and will impart knowledge of religion, non-violence and truth in view of self-development of the students.
11. Physical development of the people means training in physical exercise and manual labor will be considered essential in Vidyapith.

7. The application number will be sent to your registered email ID.

Admission Guideline

Gujarat Vidyapith offers 8 Undergraduate programmes after standard 12, 3 Postgraduate programmes, 20 Master programmes, 1 Post-graduate Diploma, and Ph.D. programmes in 16 subjects. All programmes are conducted in regular (face-to-face) mode. The medium of instruction at Gujarat Vidyapith is Gujarati

Generally, the Timings of almost all the Academic Departments will be from 10:30 am to 6:00 pm.

Program Details:

At Gujarat Vidyapith, for admissions in the academic year 2026 to various programs based on the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP-2020), the number of seats and the required minimum educational qualifications are as follows.

Educational Qualification

- For admission to CC3 and CC4, the candidate must have passed a Bachelor's degree in any subject from a recognized university with at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade.

Note: For admission to CC4, the candidate must have studied Mathematics at the Standard 12 or graduation level.

Eligibility Criterion: UGC- NET/CSIR-UGC NET in Categories:

(1) JRF OR (2) Assistant Professor without JRF (1 Year Validity) OR (3) Ph.D. (1 Year Validity)

Note: As per the rules of the Central Government, a relaxation of 5% in the minimum educational qualification will be provided to candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD categories.

Admission Process Fee: ₹600/- (Non-refundable)

Admission Procedure (for Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Postgraduate Diploma Programmes)

- To obtain admission at Gujarat Vidyapeeth, the candidate must have appeared in any one of the entrance examinations: CUET (UG)-2026, CUET (PG)-2026 conducted by the National Testing Agency, or the Gujarat Vidyapeeth Eligibility and Efficacy Test for Admission (GEETA) conducted by Gujarat Vidyapeeth.
- The entrance examination will be OMR-based.
- The candidate must appear for the entrance examination at the selected centre at their own expense.
- The entrance examination will be conducted in Gujarati, Hindi, and English medium.
- The GEETA entrance examination will consist of 60 questions with a duration of 90 minutes.

Note:

- If a student has appeared for the qualifying examination but the result has not yet been declared, the student may apply for the relevant UG/PG programme and can appear in GEETA.
- If the student fails to submit the required documents for the minimum qualification by 31 August 2026, the admission of the student will be cancelled.
- For the Admission in BPES, B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. programs a physical fitness test is mandatory.

Merit List:

- Admission to all UG/PG/PG Diploma programmes will be based on CUET/GEETA.
- The merit list will be prepared based on the marks obtained in CUET (UG) / CUET (PG)–2026 conducted by the National Testing Agency or the entrance examination (GEETA) conducted by Gujarat Vidyapith.
- Ranking in the merit list will be assigned based on marks obtained.
- Priority will be given to CUET merit, and a combined merit list will be prepared by considering both CUET and GEETA rankings in sequence.
- Admission will be granted to the students as per the merit list and availability of reserved seats for each programme.
- Allocation of the reserved seats will be done subject-wise as per the rules of the Central Government.
- Candidates who remain absent during counselling as per the prescribed schedule or who forfeit admission will be considered only if seats are available at that time.
- As per the Admission Programme–2026, if CUET results are not available at the time of counselling, seats will be reserved for CUET candidates. Meanwhile, admissions will be conducted based on the GEETA merit list for a limited number of seats as decided subject-wise by the Admission Committee of Gujarat Vidyapith for the year 2026. Once CUET results are declared, counselling will be conducted for those seats. If seats still remain vacant, admissions will be offered based on the GEETA merit list.

Note: Candidates are advised to visit the official website of Gujarat Vidyapith (www.gujaratvidyapith.org) regularly for the latest updates regarding admission.



Criteria for Candidates with Equal Merit Scores:

Criteria I: Marks obtained in the final qualifying examination will be considered.

Criteria II: Marks obtained in the previous qualifying examination will be considered.

Criteria III: Marks in the relevant subject will be considered.

Criteria IV: The candidate who is older (based on date of birth) will be given priority.

Note:

- Even after applying the above criteria, if two or more candidates have the same score, the Vice-Chancellor of Gujarat Vidyapith will have the discretionary authority to resolve the tie. Any decision taken by the Vice-Chancellor in this regard shall be binding on all and will be final for determining merit.
- If required, an oral examination (interview) may be conducted for admission to specific faculties. Admissions will then be granted based on the merit list, giving 70% weightage to GEETA and 30% weightage to the oral examination.

Counselling and Admission Process:

- Candidates who are called for counselling and admission must remain present on the scheduled date and time at the campus of Gujarat Vidyapith, Ahmedabad, with all required original documents along with self-attested copies for verification.
- If any discrepancy is found during document verification, the admission will be cancelled automatically.
- In case of any directions received from the Government or any competent authority, the venue and mode of counselling and admission may be changed.
- Admission will be considered confirmed only after payment of the registration fee and session fee for the respective courses on the date of counselling and admission.

Documents Required at the Time of Counselling/Interview

- Original documents along with self-attested copies
- Mark sheet of Standard 12 for undergraduate admission
- Mark sheet of graduation for Postgraduate Admission, and graduation mark sheet for Postgraduate Diploma programs

- For Ph.D. admission: Postgraduate mark sheet, UGC-NET/UGC-CSIR certificate, and No Objection Certificate (NOC) (for part-time candidates)
- Aadhaar Card
- Caste certificate issued by the competent authority as per Central Government norms for candidates belonging to SC, ST, SEBC, and EWS categories
- Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate for SEBC/OBC candidates issued by the competent authority as per Central Government norms

- Registration fee (non-refundable) shall be paid at the time of admission to the program.
- The first semester fee shall be paid at the time of confirming admission. In case the admission is cancelled under unavoidable circumstances, the fee shall be refunded as per the rules.
 - The above-mentioned fee structure shall be applicable to students admitted from the Guru Purnima session.
 - For each programme, additional credits (per 15 hours) will be charged at the rate of ₹1000.

Important Note:

As per the National Education Policy 2020 (based on minimum eligibility), if a student wishes to discontinue the program, the following provisions shall apply for Undergraduate programs:

After completion of one year (2 semesters) – a Certificate shall be awarded, and after completion of two years (4 semesters) – a Diploma shall be awarded.

For Postgraduate programs: After completion of the first year (2 semesters) – a Postgraduate Diploma shall be awarded.

- In case of M.A Journalism and Mass Communication, the students, leaving the program after completion of the first year, will be awarded either PG Diploma in Digital Media Production or PG Diploma in Journalism and Mass Communication based on the specialization opted by the student.
- In case of M.Y.A. Sc., the students, leaving the program after completion of the first year, will be awarded PG Diploma in Yoga.
- In case of M.Lib.I.Sc., the students, leaving the program after completion of the first year, will be awarded B.Lib.I.Sc. degree.



Rules for the Ph.D. Programme

1. Applicable Regulations for Ph.D. Program:

- Regulation: University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022
- Rules: Gujarat Vidyapith Rules, 2024

2. Admission Procedure :

- I. Candidates qualified under UGC-NET Category 1 shall be admitted to the Ph.D. programme based on an interview.
- II. Candidates qualified under UGC-NET Categories 2 and 3 shall be considered with 70% weightage of marks obtained in the NET examination and 30% weightage of marks obtained in the interview.
 - Thus, Ph.D. admission shall be based on the combined merit of marks obtained in UGC-NET and the interview/ viva.
 - The UGC-NET scores of candidates qualified under Categories 2 and 3 shall be valid for a period of one year for Ph.D. admission. Accordingly, only the candidates who have qualified UGC-NET/CSIR UGC-NET in June 2025 or December 2025 shall be eligible to apply.

Ph.D. (Part-Time):

- 1) Candidates who are employed full-time in academic institutions/research organizations shall be permitted to pursue the Ph.D. program through the part-time mode.
- 2) Such candidates must submit a No Objection Certificate (NOC) for this program, duly issued by the competent authority of the institution where they are employed.

Allocation of the Reserved Seats: (As per Central Government rules)

Reservation of Seats:

- Scheduled Caste (SC) : 15%
- Scheduled Tribe (ST) : 7.5%
- Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC) : 27%

Note:

1. 10% of the total seats shall be reserved for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS).
2. In accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016, 5% of seats in each program shall be reserved for people with disabilities.

(“Person with Disability” means an individual certified by a competent medical authority as having not less than 40% of any disability.)



Code of Conduct of Gujarat Vidyapith

- **Uniform:**

Admitted students shall wear the prescribed Khadi uniform.

- **Upasana:**

Students are required to attend Prayer assembly regularly.

- **Community Life:**

The daily routine of students shall be based on the principles of community living.

Every student shall regularly practice hand-spinning using the charkha (spinning wheel).

- **Hostel:**

Hostel accommodation is optional for students.

- **Equality:**

In this ragging-free campus environment, principles of equality towards all the students must be uniformly upheld and strictly maintained by one and all.

- **Practical Exposure:**

Students shall gain practical experience of the relevant tasks as part of their studies.

- **Field Work:**

Students shall undertake fieldwork relevant to their subject.

- **Gram Jivan Yatra:**

Every student shall participate in the Gram Jivan Yatra (One Week), an event organized by Vidyapith.

- Upload your recent photograph in the correct size as specified in the guidelines.
- Do not upload selfies or photographs taken using a mobile/iPad/digital camera.
- It is advisable to use a laptop or desktop to fill the application form.
- Use the latest version of a browser such as Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox.
- The admission process fee can be paid via debit card, credit card, net banking, or UPI.
